## Why Breakfast Club?

Research shows children and young people are more likely to achieve their learning potential when they have breakfast.

Breakfast programs improve physical health and additional social, cultural and emotional wellbeing benefits.

## What is happening?

We are very fortunate to be partnering with Foodbank and Streaky Bay Foodland to start a new, free, Breakfast Program at Miltaburra Area School.

Students/pre-schoolers will be able to access the Breakfast Program every morning from when they arrive at school until the first bell.

## A note on dietary requirements.

Gluten Free will be available. Lactose Free will be available.
Breakfast Club will be nut-free.

If you have a child who has any food allergies or restrictions the school is not yet aware of, please notify the school as soon as possible.
