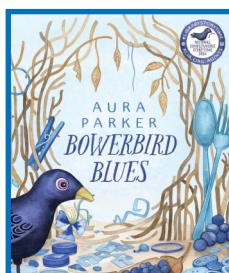
Aish - "It made me happy because she made it fun."
