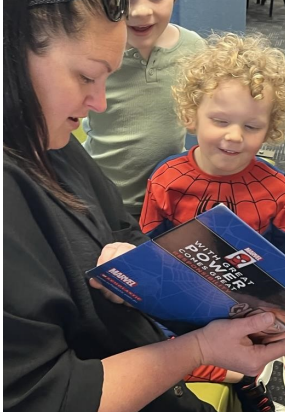

**BEST BOOK CHARACTER**

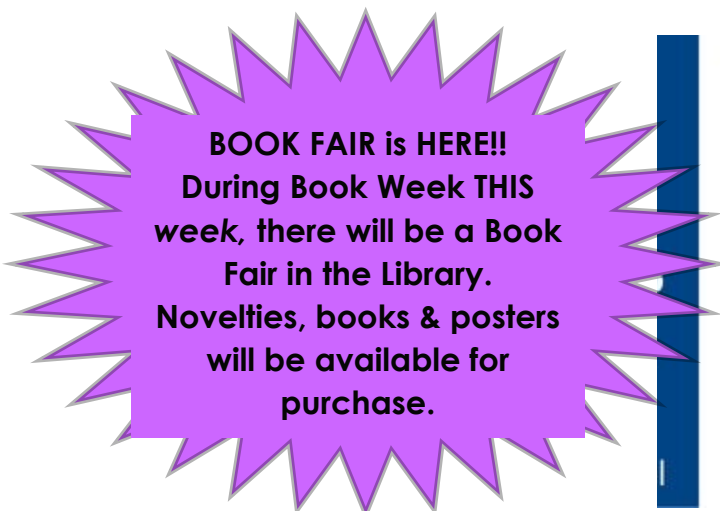

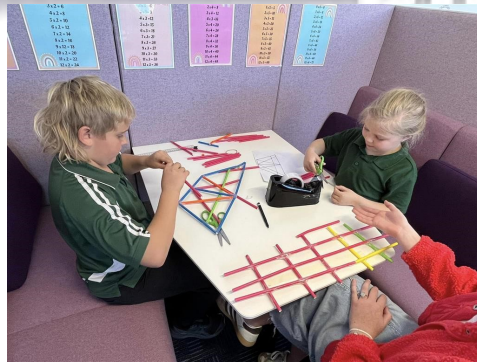

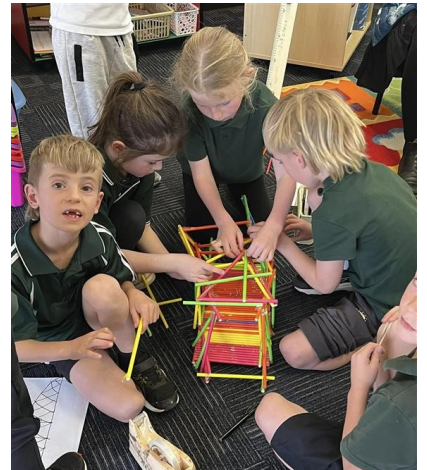
# BUILDING BRIDGES



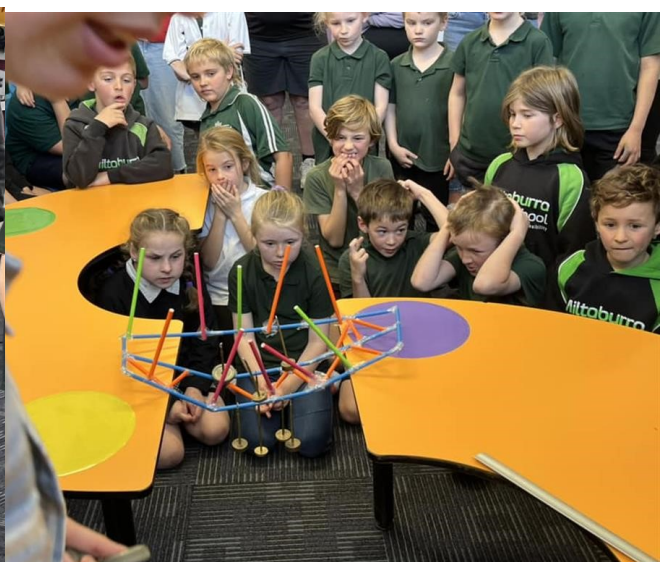
We designed a bridge that would structurally would take the most weight using arches and triangles.
