Miltaburra Area School **TALENT SHOW** is coming up, and we're inviting students **and** parents to take the stage!


Whether you love to sing, dance, perform magic, or have a hidden talent, we would love to see it.




On Monday the 11th of November, the 7-10 class will be running a Remembrance Day Ceremony. We are inviting community members in from 10:30am. It would be great to see you there.
