Whether you love to sing, dance, perform magic, or have a hidden talent, we would love to see it.

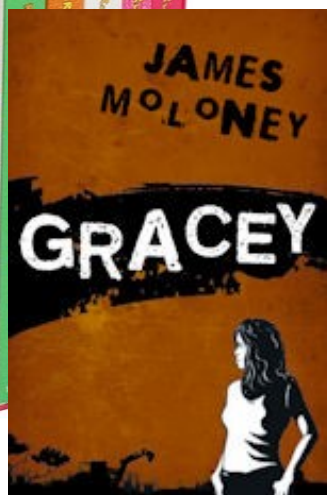
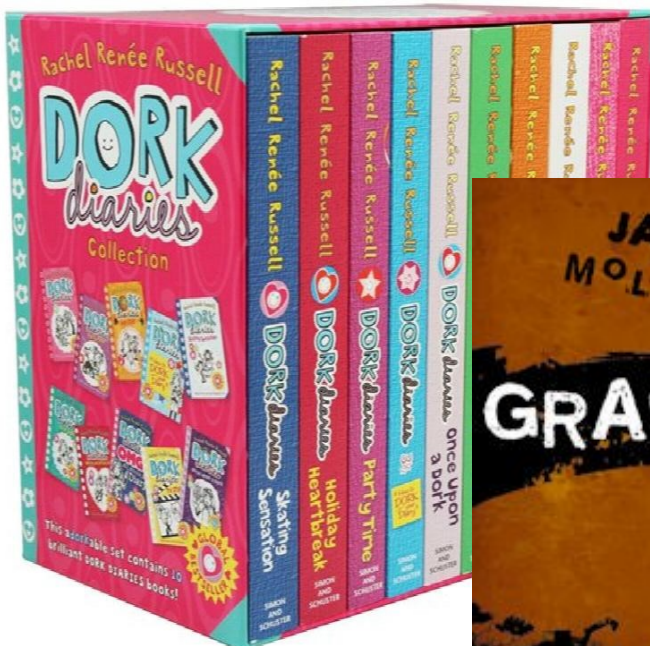

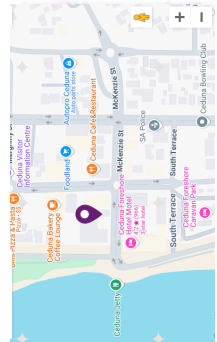
